Fiuzza Sauvignon Blanc belongs to our collection of single varietal wines. Fiuzza was pioneer in introducing French grapes in Portugal having some of the oldest vines of this grape variety. It's a wine produced to express the best characteristics of this grape in our *terroir*.

Palate: The wine is mouth filling, crispy, with passion fruit flavor and good structure. Long and well balanced finish.

Drinking temperature: Drink at 11°C to 13°C (52°F to 55°F)

Food pairing: Enjoy as aperitif and with grilled fish, white meat, seafood, goat cheese and feta salads, asparagus, avocado and Thai food.
